THE SYMONDS & SAMPSON HONITON SHOW 'VEGETABLE VEHICLE' COMPETITION

- Entries will be judged by Association President and President Elect, Neil Parish MP and Mel Squires
- Entries close at 12 noon on Thursday 23 July 2020, and winners will be announced on what would have been 'show day', 6 August 2020.
- Prizes: The winner of each class will receive two adult tickets to the 2021 show, a rosette and prize card. Prize cards will be awarded to 2nd and 3rd place in each class.

The Classes

- Class 1 A Vegetable Vehicle, not exceeding 30cm in length, created by children under 7 years of age on 6 August
- Class 2 A Vegetable Vehicle, not exceeding 30cm in length, created by children age 7 - 10 years of age on 6 August
- Class 3 A Vegetable Vehicle, not exceeding 30cm in length, created by children age 11 – 15 years of age on the 6 August
